Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Home Learning! Following on from our Google Classroom letter, we would like to lay out how we are going to provide online teaching and learning for your child going forward now that you have had the chance to log in to Google Suite at home.

Each year group: Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, will have an allocated time during each day where they will interact and be guided and taught by their class teacher on the relevant subject matter at the relevant level. All you need to do is click on the link in the classroom at the **correct** relevant time. Class teachers will be uploading a more detailed time table and plan to the Acorns Classroom but for now, for your reference, these are the allocated times for Google Meet:

Year 2 – 9:30am
Year 1 – 11:00am
Reception – 1:30pm

In addition to attending Google Meet, each day your children will be given Maths, English and Phonics learning along with elements of the broader curriculum. The material for these will be uploaded to the classwork area the previous day. A weekly schedule of the planned learning will be uploaded to Google Classroom by Monday, 11th January.

Please aim to have the children ready to join us for Google classroom at the allocated time with the microphone on mute, please show them how to unmute when needed, thank you. Outside of these times there are activities the children can do and these will be detailed in the Daily Set Learning Schedule.

These online sessions with the class teachers are of the utmost importance to ensure your child remains engaged with their education. It is also a chance to see their friends and talk to others outside of the family home. We expect every child to attend. With this in mind please can you inform the school office emails whether you need to loan a chrome book or ipad from the schools. We will happily deliver!

We are here to support your child through this new learning experience so please contact us via the School office or via the teachers' email addresses if you have any problems. Thank you.
