# Let you light Shine Job Description

**Purpose of the job:** To teach pupils within the school and to carry out other associated duties as are reasonably assigned by the Headteacher

The post holder will be expected to meet the professional standards set out in the Department for Education's (DfE) teachers' standards document.

#### **Applicable Contract Terms and Duties:**

This job description is to be performed in accordance with the provisions of the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document and within the range of duties set out in that document so far as is relevant to the post holder's title and salary grade. To fulfill all standards for QTS and Core as laid out by the DCSF in the Professional Standards for Teachers

#### Relationships:

The post holder is responsible to the Headteacher for his/her teaching duties and responsibilities for teaching tasks. The post holder may be responsible for the supervision of the work of the classroom assistants relevant to his /her responsibilities.

#### Particular Responsibilities:

The particular responsibilities attaching to the post of class teacher are as follows:

To teach according to their educational needs, pupils assigned to him/her in the allocated class.

- To control and oversee the use and storage of books and other teaching resources provided for class usage and to supervise the work of teaching assistants relevant to the allocated class.
- To maintain discipline in accordance with the rules and disciplinary systems of the school.
- To contribute to meetings, discussions and management systems necessary to co-ordinate the work of the school as a whole.
- To promote equal opportunities within the school and to seek to ensure the implementation of the school's equal opportunity policy.
- To follow school procedures to protect and safeguard the welfare of pupils and staff

#### **Key Tasks:**

The key tasks attaching to the post of class teacher are:

- To plan, with reference to the school's Scheme of Work, for teaching a broad and balanced curriculum covering all statutory elements of the National Curriculum.
- To monitor and report to parents on the progress of pupils in the allocated class.
- To assess and analyse pupils' achievements and progress in accordance with arrangements agreed within the school
- To mark class attendance registers.
- To provide feedback to pupils both written and verbal on what they are already doing well and what they need
  to do next.
- To maintain effective records in accordance with school policy
- To provide a neat, inspiring and orderly classroom environment in which effective learning can take place.
