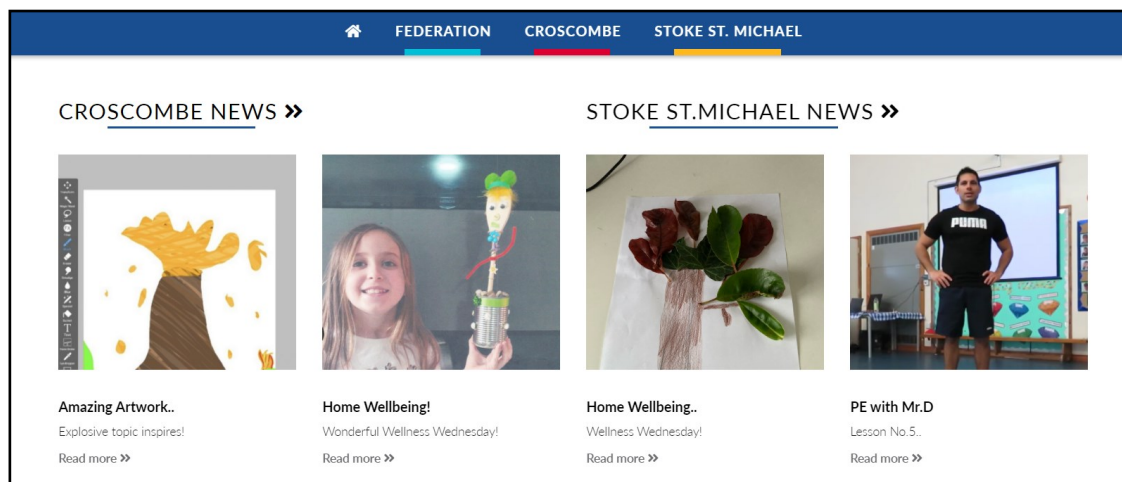


## Latest News
