In April 2016, we were approved a grant from the National Lottery, to create an allotment space for the use of the children. Over the last 12 months, a small team of us have been working extremely hard, lovingly creating this space for the Croscombe children to enjoy, building an area where they can experience growing their own food.

On Thursday April 20th, we will be holding our 'Easter Eggstravaganza & Garden Party', where we will officially open our Edible Garden. The children will be going up to the school field from 1pm where we will have an Easter Egg Hunt, an inflatable assault course, and fun and games. We will also be having various stalls offering products for sale in the Village Hall.

To open our garden, we have invited the head gardener from The Bishops Palace.

The event will run between 1pm and 4pm.

As we do for the Christmas market, we would like to ask for parent donations of the following:

Jam jars filled for the tombola

Items for an Easter Hamper raffle

As always, we would also like to ask if any of you would volunteer to help out on the day. A rota will be on the main door from Monday

The Easter Egg Hunt will work in two ways:

- 1, If parents ARE attending, you can choose to hunt around the village or around the field,
- 2, If parents are NOT attending, children will go on their hunts around the field, garden and conservation areas.

The Easter egg hunt is £3 per child.

You will need to book your child onto this in advance using the slip below. This is so we can get the right number of eggs.
