Time to snuggle up and cosy down!

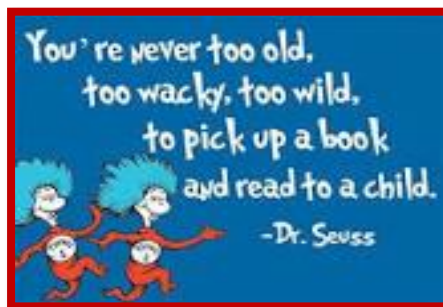
This holiday, once you have finally finished dashing around, why not make time to **read**?
